Day 1: Arrive Ayers Rock

Day 2: Kata Tjuta (the Olgas)

This morning you may wish to join an early tour to view sunrise at Uluru. Walk into Mutitjulu Waterhole and stop at the Uluru - Kata Tjuta Cultural Centre. Visit Kata Tjuta and walk into Walpa Gorge. Enjoy sunset with a complimentary glass of wine, followed by a delicious barbecue dinner under the stars. **B HD**

Day 3: Kings Canyon

Travel to Kings Canyon today. For the energetic, a guided climb to the canyon rim will be rewarded with magnificent views of Watarrka National Park.

Hotel: Kings Canyon Resort, Kings Canyon. **B D**

Day 4: Alice Springs

Leaving Watarrka National Park behind, we travel through to Alice Springs. See the sights of Alice Springs, including the Royal Flying Doctor Service, School of the Air and the Telegraph Station. Stop for panoramic views from Anzac Hill.

Day 5: Alice Springs Desert Park

Day 8: Katherine Gorge - Kakadu

Day 9: Kakadu - Darwin

We stop at Bowali Visitor Centre. Travel to Ubirr and climb to the top of this rocky outcrop for rewarding views. Travel to Darwin and enjoy a sightseeing tour.

Hotel: Mantra Pandanas, Darwin, 3 nights. **B**

Day 10: Litchfield National Park

Travel to Litchfield National Park to see beautiful Florence Falls, Wangi Falls and the Magnetic Termite Mounds. Dine out this evening at Crocosaurus Cove. Enter the world of the awesome Northern Territory saltwater crocodile. See the largest display in the world of Australian reptiles, a two storey fresh water aquarium, a turtle sanctuary and local Aboriginal art and culture displays. **B HD**

See the Ord River Irrigation Scheme, Hidden Valley National Park and visit Kelly's Knob Lookout. **B D**

Day 15: Parry Lagoon - Wyndham

Travel to Parry Lagoon Nature Reserve. See the birdlife and learn about traditional lifestyles. Continue to Wyndham to the 5 Rivers Lookout. Visit Warri Park to see Dreamtime Statues before arriving in El Questro.

Hotel: Emma Gorge Resort, tented cabins with private facilities, El Questro, 2 nights. **B D**
