Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive Darwin

On arrival in Darwin you will be transferred to your hotel. Meet your Tour Director and enjoy a tour of the city.

Hotel: Mantra on the Esplanade, Darwin. **D**

Day 2: Katherine Gorge

Head south towards Katherine. Stop at the Adelaide River War Cemetery and cruise through Katherine Gorge.

Hotel: Paraway Motel, Katherine. **B D**

Day 3: Ord River Cruise

Travel to Lake Argyle. Cruise on the Ord River to Kununurra. This permanent water supply has formed wetland areas, which have become havens for myriads of birds and a variety of marsupials that inhabit the islands in the lake.

Hotel: Country Club Hotel, Kununurra, 2 nights. **B D**

Day 4: Kununurra

See the Ord River Irrigation Scheme and Hidden Valley National Park. **B D**

Day 5: Wyndham

This morning travel to Parry Lagoon Nature Reserve. Continue to the 5 Rivers Lookout, for sensational views over the Cambridge Gulf, then on to El Questro.

Hotel: Emma Gorge Resort, tented cabins with private facilities, 2 nights. **B D**

Day 6: El Questro

Cruise through Chamberlain Gorge, a three-kilometre fresh waterhole abounded by tropical vegetation and 60 metre tall escarpments. At Emma Gorge Resort there is time to sit by the pool or to hike into Emma Gorge for a refreshing swim in the waterhole. **B D**

Day 7: Lirrgarn Argyle Diamond Mine

Visit the Lirrgarn Argyle Diamond Mine for a guided tour of the world's largest diamond mine. Continue to Halls Creek.

Day 8: Geikie Gorge

Travel to Fitzroy Crossing. This afternoon enjoy a cruise through Geikie Gorge.

Day 9: Derby - Broome

Day 12: The Pilbara

Travel into Karijini National Park.

Hotel: Karijini Eco Retreat, deluxe eco tents with en suites, Karijini NP. **B D**

Day 13: Karijini National Park

We explore Karijini National Park. Travel to Tom Price for a guided tour of the Pilbara Open Cut Iron Ore Mine.

Hotel: Rocklea Palms, Paraburdoo. **B L D**

Day 14: North West Cape

Today visit Giralia Station. This afternoon travel to Exmouth on the boundary of the Ningaloo Marine Park.

Hotel: Potshot Hotel Resort, Exmouth. **B L D**

Day 15: Ningaloo Reef

Travel to Coral Bay and join a sub-sea viewer over the Ningaloo Reef, Western Australia's largest coral reef. Visit Shell Beach and continue to Monkey Mia.
